DAY 1 AMSTERDAM

Arrival at the Airport, your ride to the hotel will be by SIC transfer at the time agreed. Head to the city for hotel check-in (2PM – 3PM onwards; you may leave your bags at the hotel for safekeeping and take a stroll in the city). You may purchase our optional attractions to make the tour more memorable. Don't forget to check out the Instagram-able spots! Good night sleep at the hotel.

DAY 2 AMSTERDAM

Caffé and pastries to start the day like the westerners. Meet up with your friendly tour leader at the lobby, a little get-to-know and start off the tour with (**Spring season only: Keukenhof Tulip Festival.) Visit to Zaanse Schanns Village for photos of the picturesque traditional Dutch village, windmills and also a clog and cheese-making demonstration. Then we proceed Amsterdam city for a Diamond-making demonstration at the Royal Coster Diamond – the oldest operating diamond polishing factory in the world, earning its Royal title from King Willem-Alexander. Don't be shy to tell them your budget, you'd be surprised. Later, we'll have a cruise along the canals for an hour, enjoy the canals and the beautiful dutch buildings and boat-houses parked at the canal – audio guide provided. We'll have a little walk to Damrak Square for shopping activity (you can also walk to Red Light District if time permits). Dinner will be served at the restaurant and back to hotel.

DAY 3 B/D AMSTERDAM/COLOGNE/HEIDELBERG

Caffe and Rosti for breakfast to kick start the day at the hotel. We will then check-out from the hotel and start our roadtrip to Cologne, Germany. Upon arrival at Cologne, we'll have a photo-stop at Cologne Cathedral - a renowned monument of German Catholicism and Gothic architecture and was declared a World Heritage Site in 1996. Then, we'll visit the House of 4711 - the World's First Eau de Cologne before continue our journey to Heidelberg where we'll have dinner at the restaurant and check-in hotel

DAY 4 HEIDELBERG/LUCERNE/ZURICH B/D

Tea and bread rolls for breakfast at the hotel like the Germans, group will check-out from the hotel and proceed to Lucerne for an orientation tour where the group will have photostop at Chapel Bridge - the oldest wooden covered bridge in Europe which serves as the city's symbol and one of Switzerland's main attraction and Lion Monument - commemorates the Swiss Guards who were massacred in 1792 during the French Revolution, when revolutionaries stormed the Tuileries Palace in Paris. Then you will have some free and easy for famous swiss products shopping such as chocolates and watches before continuing our journey to Zurich for dinner at restaurant and check-in hotel.

DAY 5 ZURICH/VADUZ/INNSBRUCK

Start the day with a hearty breakfast at the hotel. Group will check-out from hotel and proceed to Vaduz, the capital city of Liechtenstein where the group will be meeting with a local guide for a guided tour of Vaduz where we will be visiting the Old Rhine bridge Vaduz-Sevelen - A 135 meters long and represents the last surviving wooden bridge that crosses between two countries and also Vaduz Castle - the palace and official residence of the Prince of Liechtenstein for a photo stop. Then we will have free and easy activity at Stadtle Street - lined with shops, restaurants, and other venues, it is the main and only pedestrian street in Vaduz. Take a stroll down this path to soak in the culture of Lichtenstein, a combination of cultures between the neighbouring countries. Before continuing our journey to Innsbruck we will have a quick photo stop at Guttenberg Castle - a preserved castle in the town of Balzers, Liechtenstein. It is one of the five castles of the principality and one of two that have survived preserved until the present day. Upon arrival in Innsbruck, we will have dinner at the restaurant before check-in at the hotel for a good night rest

DAY 6 INNSBRUCK

Café and Croissant for breakfast at the hotel before our journey to Wattens where we will visit the amazing Swarovski Kristallwelten Garden - Sparkling Chambers of Wonder, a Swarovski museum and a fascinating garden at its home country. Then, we will head back to Innsbruck for a Mountain Excursion at Nordkette - The breathtaking 360° view leaves a lasting impression, with the capital of the Alps on one side and Tyrol's most extensive conservation area on the other. Then we will take a descend and proceed to Innsbruck Old Town - full of historic and architectural gems within easy walking distance of each other. Feel the experience of travelling back in time strolling through the 800 year old city center of Innsbruck. Dinner will be served in the restaurant and we'll head back to the hotel after.

DAY 7 INNSBRUCK/VERONA/MILAN

Yogurt and milk for breakfast at the hotel. After breakfast, we will head for an approximately 4 hours drive to Verona where we will have an orientation tour, stopping by at Arena di Verona - a Roman amphitheatre in Piazza Bra in Verona, Italy built in the first century and Juliet Balcony - Gothic-style 1300s house and museum, with a stone balcony, said to have inspired Shakespeare. Then we will have some free and easy before continuing our journey to Milan. Upon arrival, we will have dinner at the restaurant before check-in hotel

DAY 8 MILAN B/D

Café and Pastries for breakfast like the Italians. We will start the day by heading to Serravalle Designer Outlet for shopping – 30-70% off all year round! Then we will proceed for a walking guided tour of Milan where we will have the chance to take pictures of the majestic Milan Cathedral - Dedicated to St Mary of the Nativity, it is the seat of the Archbishop of Milan. The cathedral took nearly six centuries to complete. Which is located at Piazza del Duomo - the main piazza of Milan, Italy. We will also visit Galleria Vittorio Emanuele II - Italy's oldest active shopping mall and a major landmark of Milan, Italy and La Scala Opera House - Considered one of the most important and famous theatres in the world, known as the 'Temple of Opera'. Then we will have some free and easy activity for you to roam around before we head for dinner at the restaurant and later back to the hotel.
