DAY 1 ROME

Arrival at the Airport, your ride to the hotel will be by SIC transfer at the time agreed. Head to the city for hotel check-in (2PM – 3PM onwards; you may leave your bags at the hotel for safekeeping and take a stroll in the city). You may purchase our optional attractions to make the tour more memorable. Don't forget to check out the Instagram-able spots! Good night sleep at the hotel.

DAY 2 ROME B/D

Café and bread to start the day like the Romans. Meet up with your friendly tour leader at the lobby, a little get-to-know and start the tour with a walking guided tour where we'll visit Trevi Fountain - throwing a coin in the Trevi Fountain means you'll return to Rome someday (bring coins!). From the fountain we'll walk to the famous Spanish Steps for photos and then we will travel by bus for a photo session at the Roman Forum - ruins of ancient government buildings at the city of Rome and not to forget the UNESCO World Heritage Colosseum - as seen in the movie Gladiator, the large Roman Amphitheatre. Lastly, our final photostop for the day will be at the small country of Vatican City; The headquarters of the Roman Catholic Church and home of the pope. We will have a quick stop at St. Peter's Basilica - as seen in the movie Angels & Demons; also known as where the Pope usually goes out to meet the people. We will then proceed to Via Condotti Street for Shopping activity before having dinner at the restaurant and back to the hotel for some rest.

DAY 3 ROME/PISA/FLORENCE B/D

Western breakfast at the hotel to energize for the day and checkout from hotel. We will proceed to Pisa to visit Square of Miracles for amazing panoramic photos of Pisa Cathedral, Pisa Baptistery, and the Leaning Tower of Pisa - known worldwide for its unintended tilt. Take picture that looks like you're pushing the tower! Then we will continue our journey to Florence. Upon arrival, we will stop by at Pierotucci Leather Factory – an Italian leather factory with its own retail leather as well as manufacturer for high-end brands where we will learn about Florentine handcraft leather and some shopping at the factory. Later we will have dinner at the restaurant and back to hotel.

DAY 4 FLORENCE/MESTRE

Eggs and toast for breakfast at the hotel and start the tour by bus for guided tour of Florence passing through attractions and beautiful Italian renaissance architecture. We will stop for photo session at Piazzale Michelangelo – a square with a panoramic view of Florence, Italy. Santa Croce – the principal Franciscan church in Florence, Italy, and a minor basilica of the Roman Catholic Church. Piazza Repubblica – originally the site of the city's forum; then of its old ghetto and Piazza Signoria – the main point of the origin and history of the Florentine Republic and still maintains its reputation as the political focus of the city. Make sure your camera's storage is enough for the day! Later you are able to get some rest as we proceed for dinner in Mestre and then check-in to our hotel in Mestre.

DAY 5 MESTRE/VENICE/MESTRE

Head down to the hotel café for breakfast and we'll start the tour of the day by proceeding to Tronchetto Pier for our boat transfer to Venice Island. Upon arrival we will go for a walking guided tour of Venice island. We'll head to San Marco Square – the principal public square of Venice where we could also find Doges Palace built in Venetian Gothic style, and one of the main landmarks of the city of Venice in northern Italy, Bridge of Sighs - one of the most famous bridges not just in Venice, but in the world, learn the shocking history behind the famous bridge and also St Mark's Basilica - built in the 9th century to house very sacred relicsrelics that had been stolen! We will also make a visit to Murano Glass Factory – where we'll see the demonstration of Venetian Glass-making. The group will have some free and easy where they are able to go for gondola rides (entrance excluded). Then we will head to San Marco Pier for our transfer back to Mestre for dinner and back to hotel.

DAY 6 MESTRE/BERGAMO/MILAN

Café and Croissant in the morning for breakfast at the hotel before check-out and we'll start the tour with an approximately 3.5hour roadtrip to Bergamo – a real masterpiece of history, culture, music and landscape, with a medieval heart on top of a hill surrounded by the majestic Venetian Walls, nominated to become a UNESCO World Heritage Site. We'll go on the funicular train to the old town at Citta Alta – a walled city on a hill with rich medieval history with a beautiful panoramic view of the modern city below and you will have some free & easy time to explore the old city. Make sure you take photo of the view and the unique buildings! Then we'll head to the restaurant at Milan and check in to the hotel.

DAY 7 MILAN

Continental breakfast at the hotel and we'll start the tour with some shopping at Serravelle Designer Outlet - Save up to 70% on a great range of designer brands. Make sure you make use of the time to shop for cheaper Milan Fashion designer brands! Then we will go for a guided tour of Milan where our local guide will brief about the city of Milan and we will have photo sessions at Milan Cathedral – it took nearly six centuries to complete, it is the largest church in Italy, the third largest in Europe and the fourth largest in the world. La Scala Opera House - regarded as one of the leading opera and ballet theatres in the world and also the Galleria Vittorio Emanuele II – Italy's oldest active shopping mall and a major landmark of Milan. If time permits, we will have free & easy at Galleria Vittorio Emanuele II for shopping before heading to the restaurant for dinner and back to the hotel

DAY 8 MILAN
